Morning Meeting: This is when we will touch base, do some 'get to know you' activities and connect as a class. We might eventually do a little show and tell. This is also when we will go over what is going on that particular day. This is teacher directed.

Math: We will use this time to complete a Eureka Math lesson, review concepts, and work in Zearn. This will be both teacher directed and offer opportunities for independent practice.

Balance Literacy. ELA: At this time, we will go over the expectations for balanced literacy in the classroom, I will offer independent word work practice, reading time, etc. I will also use a read aloud to introduce and reinforce the Language Arts skill we will be focusing on this week.

Break Time: This time is yours to take a break, use the restroom, grab a snack, take a walk.

Flex Time: During Flex time, Gifted and EIP students will meet in small groups with their instructors. Students who are working with me will be reinforcing skills we have learned together. I will not introduce any new skills at this time. This will be teacher-guided independent practice.

Phonics/ELA: At this time, we will learn our phonics rules for the week, practice those skills, and if time permits work more with the Language Arts skill of the week. This will be both teacher directed and offer opportunities for independent practice

Lunch/Recess: This is your time to eat and move around at home. I will not be available on the Zoom meeting at this time.

Independent Work: All students will be working independently on activities in <u>its Learning</u>. I will remain in Zoom so that students may ask questions, or get other help if needed. It would be best if students also stay in Zoom for this time, but I understand if that is not possible. This will be teacher-guided independent practice.

Specials: The specials teachers will meet us in our Zoom meetings.

<u>ELA, Science/Social Studies</u>: We will continue to learn about our ELA topic of the week as well as learn about Science or Social Studies. (Science and Social Studies units will be alternated.) This will be both teacher directed and offer opportunities for independent practice.

<u>Wednesdays</u>: This day is an opportunity for students to complete work in its learning independently. I will also be scheduling small groups based on the needs of the students.
